  - **a.** During the semiannual meetings or between if necessary, the IACUC will submit a written report to the IO outlining any recommendations for or revisions to the animal care and use program.









**d.** The IO will receive a copy of the IACUC meeting minutes that records all decisions regarding protocol review and activities.






